Gerrard Hopkins requested of this meeting on behalf of him self & sundry other friends in the parts where he lives that they may have the liberty to build a meeting house about half way from his house to Rich snowdens Iron works to keep meeting for worship of Almighty God on Every first day & to make report of the state of these meetings to our monthly & quarterly meetings by the name of Indon Spring meeting this meeting have taken the request under their Consideration and are unanimous in their minds that they shall have a meeting as requested

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for further business therefore this meeting adjourns to the next quarterly meeting.

At a quarterly meeting held at Gunpowder meeting house in Baltimore County 4th day of 4th 1759 This meeting proceeded as usual to inspect into what business may there to occur.
