Many Friends endeavour to educate their Children, and those under their care in plainness of speech, deportment and Apparel, to guard them from reading pernicious Books, and from corrupt conversation, also, to encourage them in reading the Holy Scriptures. Yet deficiencies in these respects are still apparent.

4th Friends are in a good degree clear of the particulars mentioned in the fore part of that Query, And many friends are careful to observe moderation and temperance.

5th The necessities of the Poor are inspected and they in a good degree relieved, and care is taken to promote the School education of their Children.

6th As far as appears our testimony has been in a good degree supported against an hireling Ministry. Clear, as respects the further particulars of the query.

7th Most Friends appear careful to live within the bounds of their circumstances, and to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage - Justice in dealing, and punctuality in fulfilling of contracts generally observed.

8th

Generally careful to bear a testimony against Slavery, and to provide in a suitable manner for those under their ~~direction~~ who have had their freedom secured, And we hope that an increased care is taken to instruct them in useful learning.

9th Friends are in a good degree careful to observe the requisitions of this Query.
