An extract from our late yearly meeting containing some of its important exercises on account of the many invasions made by the enemy within our border, was read, and copious thereof directed to be handed down to our several monthly meetings.

Our esteemed friend Mildred Radcliff attended this meeting and produced a certificate from Short Creek Monthly meeting this dated the 22nd of the 6th month 1819 endorsed by the quarter which was read and with her gospel services were acceptable. Also her companion Mary Steer attended with a minute from Concord monthly meeting Ohio dated the 25th of the 8th month 1819 which with her company were acceptable. The clerk was directed to unite with the clerk of mens meeting in signing an endorsement thereon.
