Who were present except four, who
were prevented from attending by the
obstruction to travel on account of the
war. The following minute was received
from the Quarterly Meeting held at Hopewell
explaining the cause of its adjournment to
this place and time.

The following memorial of our late beloved
friend ^{& Elder} Hugh Balderson was received
from Baltimore Monthly Meeting, read
and approved and our clerks are
directed to sign it on our behalf and
forward it to the Meeting for sufferings.

The first, second and sixth Queries
