The 1st & 2nd Mo were read and the
following resolutions adopted to represent
the present state of this meeting

1st Mo. Meetings for worship & discipline have
been held and attended by our members
generally on first day mornings; In the
evening and middle of the week they
are still neglected by many - The becoming
behaviour is mostly avoided and the
hour of meeting generally observed, though
one report says that the hour
is not so well observed as is desirable

2nd Mo. Friends appear to maintain some
towards each other becoming our Christian
profession; tale bearing and detraction are
discouraged and when differences arise
endeavours are used to end them

3rd Mo. Care is mostly taken to deal with
offenders seasonably & impartially and
to win to those who will not be reclaimed
the spirit of meekness & love before judgment
is placed upon them

John Scott on behalf of the Committee
to name clerks for the ensuing year did proceed

the name of James Carey for clerk and
John C. Thomas for assistant clerk, which
was united with and they were ac-
cordingly appointed

Our beloved friend Jas. C. Thomas
opened in this meeting a concern to attend
in the Song of the Gospel the ensuing Yearly
Meeting of Philadelphia with other religious
service as may may open for it as self felt
in the within minute of Baltimore Monthly
Meeting, which claiming the serious con-
sideration of this meeting was fully united
with and our endorsement directed to
be placed upon it.
