Ans. 1st. All our meetings for worship

of storms. Those on First day morning
have been attended by our members

generally. Those on First day evenings
and in the middle of the week have
been neglected by many. Unbecoming
behavior has been generally avoided.

Ans. 2nd Friends have been preserved
in Christian love one towards another.
Talebearing & detraction have been dis-
couraged. No differences known amongst
us.

Ans. 10th. Care has been taken to deal
with offenders impartially & in the spirit
of meekness and love, but perhaps
not always as seasonably as would
be best.

The Fourth Unanswered Query was
read and seriously considered.

The subject of the need of Friends
residing at Bendersville for a meeting
house was brought before this Meeting
and was referred for further consider-
ation to our next Quarterly Meeting.
