Three Monthly Meetings reported as follows in reference to Minute 30 of the Yearly Meeting, viz:-
Baltimore - The Baltimore Committee have made inquiry either personally or by letter of 175 members; of these one is reported as using them occasionally for cooking purposes and thirty as using them for a beverage, in most cases occasionally only. The Bendisville Committee report knowing none of their members that use intoxicating liquor as a beverage or as a medicine.

Dear Creek - As far as inquiry has been made among our members in regard to the use of intoxicating liquors as a beverage, we are clear with the exception of some use of cider.

Pauluxent. - As far as the committee has been able to ascertain our members are free from the use of intoxicating liquors.
