By reports from all the Monthly Meetings it appears there are about forty members who use intoxicating liquors or a beverage - in most cases occasionally only. Three Monthly Meetings report their members free from its use.

All the queries were read and the following summary answers adopted to be forwarded in our report to the Yearly Meeting.

1 Ans. - All our meetings for worship and discipline have been held except three for worship omitted on account of storms. First day meetings attended by most Friends within reach. Mid week meetings and meetings for Discipline not so well attended. Some lack of punctuality noted; unbecoming behaviour avoided; one report says mostly avoided.

Ans 2. We believe that most Friends have Christian love for each other. Tale bearing & detraction are discouraged and when differences arise endeavours are used to end them.

Ans 3. - We believe Friends endeavor by example & precept to bring up their children & those under their care in the love of the Gospel & in proper simplicity of life. Care is taken to avoid improper reading & to encourage familiarity with the Holy Scriptures. One report says most Friends.

Ans. 4. - Friends have due regard to the freedom of the gospel ministry in harmony with our discipline.

Ans 5. - With some exceptions Friends maintain our testimony against intoxicating liquors & improper amusements.

Ans 6. - When necessity arises the poor are aided.

Ans 7. - With one exception noted in one report Friends' children
