

All the queries were read and the following summary answers adopted to be forwarded in our report to the Yearly Meeting.

1st Ans. All our meetings for worship and discipline have been held except 4 for worship and 5 for discipline.

More punctuality is desirable; imbecoming behavior is avoided.

2nd Ans. We believe Friends have love one to another in accordance with our Christian profession. Tale bearing and detraction are discouraged.

When differences arise endeavor ^{made} ~~is~~ to end them.

3rd Ans. We believe Friends generally are careful in the training of their children, guarding them from pernicious reading and corrupt associations, and encouraging them to read the Holy Scriptures. One report says we feel it ~~also~~ desirable that they should also be taught the Scriptural

grounds for the religious beliefs of our Society.

4th Ans. Friends maintain our testimony to a free gospel ministry.

5th Ans. Five meetings report clear as to this query and two say most Friends maintain our testimony against all intoxicating liquors, and avoid drinking houses and frivolous and demoralizing places of diversion. One report says we believe that a careful consideration of the question of amusements would be profitable.

6th Ans. The necessities of the poor and the circumstances of those who are likely to require aid are inspected and relieved. They are advised and assisted in such employment as they are capable of.

7th Ans. Friends' children attend
