6th. We believe the necessities of the poor are inspected and relieved, and they are aided and assisted in such employments as they are capable of.

7th. We believe friends are careful to place their children at schools taught by friends as far as practicable.

8 Friends are careful to obtain the usual requisites of this Query.

9th. We believe friends are careful to live within the bounds of their circumstances, and to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage - as far as appears they are just in their dealings and punctual in complying with their engagements.

10th. Care is taken to deal with offenders seasonably and impartially, and in the spirit of meekness and love.
