

Dear Mrs Mary H. Scott & Jane P. Edge
Watson - June 1846

The representatives were present except
four friends for whose absence
reasons were assigned.

The 1st Inv. & 10th queries were read
with the answers from the monthly
meetings, and the following summary
answers adopted as representing
the state of the meeting at this
time. The minutes of the Mon. Yearly Mtg. were read.
The minutes of the last Mtg. were
read. The committee appointed
at the last meeting to propose
the names of two friends to serve
this meeting as clerks the ensuing
year reported that they were
united in proposing the reappoint-
ment of Mary H. Thomas as clerk
and Jane P. Winslow as assistant
clerk - which being united with
they were appointed to the service.
The minutes of our late Yearly Mtg.

were read. The attention of the meeting
was called to the recommendation
of the Yearly Meeting to the subordinate
mtgs that enquiry should be made of
all our members as to the entire disuse
of all intropicating legions - The meeting
directed the clerk to send a minute to
the several monthly mtgs directing that
a committee be appointed in each of
our mtgs to make the enquiry and
to report to the Quarterly Mtg preceding
the Yearly Mtg -

The meeting also directed the clerk to
send a minute to the monthly mtgs,
in accordance with the direction of
the Yearly Mtg. recommending that
a committee be appointed in each
meeting to enquire of our members
whether they are in the daily
habit of collecting their families
together for family worship, and
the reading of the Holy Scriptures -
a report to be made to the Quarterly
