answers were adopted as nearly represen-
ting the present state of this Meeting
1st Our Ministers and Elders when of ability
are diligent in the attendance of Meetings
for worship and discipline, and we be-
lieve they encourage their families to that
religious duty
2nd Our Ministers in the exercise of their
gifts, appear careful to wait for divine
ability

3rd And We believe Ministers & Elders are in
unity, one with another, and with the mee-
tings to which they belong, Manifesting a
religious concern for the advancement of
truth, and the support of our discipline.

Meeting for the Eastern & Western districts
proposing the names of Joseph Thier Jr
Hannah Ann Tyson & Hannah Talbot
to the station of Elders, which after a time
of solid consideration thereon they
were united with, and appointed to that
