2nd Answer Ministers in the exercise of their gifts appear careful to wait for divine ability.

3rd Ans^r We believe Ministers & Elders are in unity one with another, and with the Meetings to which they belong, manifesting a religious concern for the advancement of Truth, and the support of our discipline except one case which is under care.

4th Ans^r Ministers & Elders endeavor to be good examples in uprightness, Temperance and Moderation (except one case which is under care) and are mostly careful to Educate their families in plainness of dress & Simplicity of Manners becoming our religious profession.

59 At Baltimore Quarterly Meeting of Ministers & Elders, held 9th of 12th Month 1861. By the report received from Baltimore preparative Meeting. The following friends are the representatives, viz John Scott Dick McJannet, Sarah H. Jannet & Deborah C. Thomas who were present, except one, who was prevented from attending by indisposition. No report from Hopewell at this time owing to the unsettled State of the County.

The 1st 2nd & 3rd queries were read in this Meeting & the answers as brought up from the preparative Meeting of Baltimore, and the following Summary answers adopted to represent the present State of this Meeting.
