Dear friends,

The 1st 2^d & 9th queries were read in this meeting and the answers thereto from our Preparatives, from which we comprise the following, to be forwarded in our Report to the Quarterly Meeting, to attend which as Representatives we appoint William Procter Ernieu Williams Isaac Brooks Joseph King junior.

FIRST With the exception of the meeting at Washington from which we have no information, All our meetings for worship & discipline have been held, & generally attended on First day mornings by most of our members, afternoon & other days of the week continue to be neglected by some, Unbecoming behaviour when assembled mostly avoided, & the hour of meeting generally observed:

SECOND. Friends appear careful to maintain love towards each other becoming our Christian profession, Tale-bearing & detraction are discouraged and when differences appear endeavours are used to end them:

THIRD. Endeavours are used to deal with offenders seasonably & impartially, & to exhort to those who will not be reclaimed, the spirit of meekness & love before they are disowned.
