1st all our meetings for worship & Discipline have been
held, those on first day mornings in one section are
fully attended, but other meetings (particularly
those in the middle of the week) are frequently
neglected by many on which account some
care has been expended: One report states that
all their meetings are thickly attended; unbecoming
behaviour when assembled mostly avoided
& the hour of meeting nearly observed.

2nd Friends appear careful to maintain love
towards each other becoming one Christian
profession, False hearing & Detraction
are generally discouraged & when differences
arise endeavours are used to end them.

3rd Endeavours are used to deal with offending
in the manner recommended.
