

At Baltham Monthly Meeting for the Eastern & Western Districts in unity with the annual Yearly Meetings of Friends held 6th Month 7. 1836.

The first second and ninth queries were read in this meeting from which the following summary was comprised to be forwarded to the ensuing quarterly meeting to attend which we appoint Joseph King Jr Isaac Brookes William Procter Joseph Townsend Representatives

1st Answer all our meetings for Worship & Discipline have been held; There on first day Mornings are generally duly attended, but other meetings are frequently neglected by many, on which account some care has been extended, Unbecoming behaviour therein mostly avoided, & the hour of Meeting nearly observed.

2nd Answer We trust that many friends are concerned to maintain love towards each other becoming our Christian profession, Tale bearing and detraction are mostly discouraged, and when differences arise endeavours are used to end them; In the Report from Baltham a belief is expressed that an increase of Love & more care to discourage Tale bearing would be profitable.

3rd Endeavours are used to deal with offenders nearly as queried.
