1st answer All our meetings for worship & Discipline
have been held, Those on first day Mornings
are generally duly attended, in the Report from Baltimore
it is observed that other Meetings are frequently neglected
by many, Unbecoming behaviour therein is mostly
avoided and the hour of Meeting nearly observed

2nd We believe friends generally maintain love towards
each other becoming our Christian profession & that
they are concerned to discourage Slandering
& Detraction & when differences arise endeavours
are used to end them.

3rd Many friends endeavour by example & precept
to educate their Children & those under their care
in plainness of Speech Deportment & apparel
and to guard them against reading pernicious books
and from the corrupt Conversation of the World also to
encourage those frequently reading the Holy Scriptures
but more care in these respects would be profitable
