

4th We believe our Testimony^{21A} against Distilled
Spirituous Liquors is very generally maintained
although our Report states that some have been
furnished during Harvest; that friends avoid
frequently Incessant unneccessarily, or attending
places of Diversion: Moderation & Temperance
are observed on most occasions.

5th The necessities of the poor are inspected, Relief
afforded agreeably to the requisitions of the query.

6th Friends appear careful to maintain a
faithful Testimony against an heinous
Ministry, Baths, Military Services, clandestine
Trade, prize Goods, & Lotteries

7th Most friends are careful to live within the
bounds of their Circumstances and to avoid
involving themselves in business beyond their
ability to Manage, as far as appears they
are just in their dealings and generally
punctual in complying with their engage-
ments, although some exception is noted in
this last respect in our Report; where any
have given Reasonable grounds for fear
& concern, some care has been extended to them

8th We believe that friends are careful to bear a
Testimony against Slavery, and that those of the
African Race under their direction are suitably
provided for, and they are instructed in
useful learning.
