

To Baltimore Quarterly Meeting in unity with the

to. 1st Ans:— all our Meetings both for worship and discipline
(except South Fork) have been kept up, though not so fully
attended as is desirable: Unbecoming behaviour therein
mostly avoided, and the hour of Meeting nearly observed.

2^d Ans: Love and unity appears to subsist amongst us, and
friends are careful to comply with the further requisitions of
the Query.

3rd Ans: Offenders are dealt with nearly as recommended

The following Minute was directed to be forwarded to the
Quarterly Meeting to wit To the committee appointed to examine
into the situation of South ^{Fork} Meeting report, That it appears
there has not been held a Meeting of Friends ~~since~~ at that
place for several months, and that they are of opinion that
the Meeting ought to be laid down, with which this Meeting
unites and the subject is referred to the Quarterly Meeting.

A proposition from Goon Creek Preparative Meeting was laid
before this Meeting, desiring that Hopewell Monthly
Meeting should be held alternately ~~with~~ Hopewell and
Goon Creek, with which this Meeting concurs. The subject
was referred to the Quarterly Meeting.

We have appointed Samuel F. Balderson and Jonah
Sands our representatives to the ensuing Quarterly Meeting.
