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4<sup>th</sup> Ant. Our testimony against Spirituous liquors appear to be maintained, agreeably to the discipline. Friends avoid frequenting taverns, or places of diversion, and do observe Moderation on all occasions,

5<sup>th</sup> Ant. We have no poor that require aid in Membership with us,

6<sup>th</sup> Ant. As far as appears, Friends Maintain their testimony against a hireling Ministry, Oaths, Military services, clandestine trade, prize goods, and lotteries,

7<sup>th</sup> Ant. Friends appear careful to live within the bounds of their Circumstances, And to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage. Just in their dealings, and mostly punctual in complying with their engagements,
