1st All our meetings for worship & discipline (with
the exception of one noted in one of the reports
as having been omitted during the week of
the Yearly Meeting) have been held, and
generally well attended, but those in the
afternoon, and in the middle of the
week, are frequently small, unbecoming behavior
therein mostly avoided, and the hour of
meeting generally observed.

2nd Friends generally maintain Love towards
each other respecting our Christian Professions,
Tale Bearing, & Disobedience are discouraged,
such differences as arise occasionally
are used to good therein.

3rd Endeavors are used to deal with offenders, seasonably
disparagingly, & to exhort to those who will not
be reclaimed, the spirit of meekness & love.
