

To Baltimore Quarterly Meeting in unity with the

were read in this Meeting, and the following answers
adopted to wit:

1st Ans: All our Meetings for worship and discipline have
been held, and generally attended by most of our Members,
Unbecoming behaviour therein mostly avoided, and the
hope of Meeting nearly observed.

2^d Ans: Friends maintain love towards each other as far as
appears. No apparent differences amongst us.

Slandering & detraction discouraged

3rd Ans: Endeavours are used to deal with offenders in
the measure recommended.

It is believed by friends of this meeting, that it might
be advantageous, to hold the Quarterly Meeting, ~~annually~~
heretofore held in the ninth month, on the sixth day
immediately preceding the Yearly Meeting. The Meeting
of Ministers and Elders to be held at 9 o'clock in the
morning. The Meeting for worship at 11 o'clock and the
meeting for discipline at the close of the meeting for worship.
When friends dissenting the subject is referred to the
Quarterly Meeting.
