

To Baltimore Quarterly Meeting in unity with
the Ancient Yearly Meetings of Friends to be held the
day of the 6th month 1841.
Dear friends

The Queries were read in this
Meeting, and the following answers adopted, to wit:-
1st Ans. All our meetings both for worship and discipline
have been held, and generally attended by most of
our Members: Unbecoming behaviour therein mostly
avoided, and the house of Meeting nearly obscured.

2^d Ans. Friends appear to cherish love towards each
other becoming our Christian profession. Tale bearing
and detraction discouraged, and no apparent differences
amongst us.

3^d Ans. - Most friends as both by precept and example
endeavour to educate their children, and those under
their care, in plainness of speech, behaviour & apparel.
Yet we believe more vigilance in this important
duty would be beneficial: they are guarded against
light reading and corrupt conversation, and are
encouraged frequently to read the Holy Scriptures.

4th Ans. Our testimony against distilled spirituous liquors
appears to be maintained, except in one instance during
harvest, in which case, care has been extended. Friends
avoid frequenting taverns and places of diversion.
Moderation and temperance mostly observed.

5th Ans. No poor amongst us requiring aid

6th Ans. Friends maintain a faithful testimony against
a hiring Ministry as far as appears. Endeavours are
also used to comply with the remaining requisitions of
this query.

7th Ans. Our testimony against Slavery appears to be
maintained: Those of the African race in friends
families are provided for, and some care has been taken
to instruct them in useful learning.

8th Ans. Endeavours are used to comply with the
requisitions of this Query according to ability.
