

"At Hopewell monthly meeting in unity with the ancient Yearly Meetings of Friends held at Goose Creek the 3^d day of the 3^d Month 1842.

"The first, second and ninth Queries were read in this meeting and the following answers thereto adopted, to wit;

"1st Qⁿ. - All our meetings for worship & discipline have been held & generally attended by most of our members; unbecoming behaviour therein strictly avoided, and the hour of meeting nearly observed.

"2^d Qⁿ. - Friends maintain love towards each other, as far as appears; talebearing & detraction discouraged, and no differences known amongst us.

"3^d Qⁿ. - Care is taken to deal with offenders as ability is afforded - manifesting a spirit of meekness and love before they are disowned."
