11th of the 2^d M^o: 1796

The friends appointed report, they attended last Quarterly Meeting, & inform, that that meeting recommended the procuring of subscriptions for the purpose of purchasing a lot of Ground in this Town for the accommodation of the Yearly Meeting.

John Marsh and Joseph Townsends are appointed for that service, as also to collect the money already subscribed for said purpose & inform next meeting thereof

10th of the 3^d M^o: 1796

The Committee appointed to procure subscriptions for the purchase of a lot of Ground are continued they not-

Having fully gone through the same, 11th M^o: 9th continued 14th of 7th & 11th of 8th continued.

8th of 9th M^o: 1796.

The friends appointed having completed their subscriptions towards the purchase of a lot of Ground are directed to forward the money to the ensuing Yearly meeting as directed by last Quarter.

12th of 1st M^o: 1797

Elisha Tyson, & William Haywards are appointed to procure further subscriptions, for the purpose of completing the payment, of the lot of Ground purchased as recommended by last Yearly meeting. Who were continued monthly until the 9th of the 11th M^o: following, when the following entry was made.

The Committee appointed report, they have completed the collection of the money subscribed for a lot of Ground & paid \$102 into the hands of the Treasurer.

10th of 1st M^o: 1799

The principal parts of the extracts of our last Yearly meeting were read over and that part thereof relative to friends of this City improving the lot of Ground, purchased for the accommodation of the Yearly meeting, being considered, & it appearing to be the united sense of this meeting, that the following friends be appointed to take the subject under their solid consideration, & if upon a mature deliberation thereof, they should be of opinion, that the time was come to move forward in that important undertaking, procure a draft for a suitable meeting house for the said lot, also endeavour for an estimate of the expence that would be likely
