We have attended to the business of our appointment & an opportunity offering have in conjunction with the committee of the Yearly meeting disposed of the lot of Ground hitherto purchased, agreeably to the former prospect of the Monthly Meeting for the sum of \$1725. the original cost, we have also purchased a lot of Ground about 100 feet by 170, situate on Lombard Street, between Howard & Eutaw Streets, the cost of which, will be about \$4,200 in full simple, We further inform that we have opened subscriptions for the building of a new meeting house, and have obtained about \$9100 for the purpose and have a prospect of further subscriptions, & after a full communication of sentiment are united in judgment that a house 80 feet long and 60 wide ought to be commenced as early as will be practicable, and as it is of importance, that such a building be under the direction of well qualified friends we are free to propose for that appointment, John M.
