To Call on Monthly Meeting.

We the Committee appointed on the request of friends of the west end of the City, inform that we have been favoured to unite in prospect, in allowing them the privilege of holding meetings in the new meeting house, that liberty be given them to hold a meeting for worship on the 4th day of the week, to begin at the 10th hour, in the morning, also a morning meeting on first day at the same hour, & a meeting in the afternoon, of the same day to be held alternately at the third hour, untill the first of the fourth month and from that time until the first of the 10th month ensuing at the 4th hour.

We have also agreed to propose that all friends west of Calvert street to its intersection with Jones's Falls and thence along the falls to the road called the Falls Turnpike be considered as members of said meeting. We are also free to propose that friends between Calvert & South streets be allowed the privilege of becoming members of either meeting which they may incline to choose, as also, those in the country who are contiguous to and upon the east side of the aforesaid Turnpike. All which we submit to the meeting.
