8th of the 5th 1806

An Extract from the minutes of the Quarterly meeting was
received and is as follows.

Baltimore monthly meeting proposes the establishment of
a meeting for worship to be held in the new meeting house
situate on Lombard street, in the west end of this city,
which being considered is united with, and the following
times for holding the same, viz, meetings on the 4th and
1st days of the week, to begin at the 10th hour, and a
meeting to be held in the afternoon on 1st days to begin at
the 4th hour from the first of the 4th month to the 1st of the
10th month, & from the first of the 10th month to the first
of the 4th month at the Court house, and the line of Calvert-
street untill it ^{intersects} Jones's Alley, then up said Alley to the
road known by the name of the Falls Turnpike, then up-
said road, and that to be considered the line of division
nevertheless friends residing between Calvert and South-
streets, and contiguous to and eastward of said road
to be at liberty to be considered members of which meeting
they may choose. The meeting to be known by the name of
Lombard Street meeting.

12th of the 6th month 1806

The following report was produced.

We of the Committee, appointed to attend and confer
with friends of Lombard street meeting respecting the esta-
blishment of a preparative meeting at that place, report we
have attended said meeting and conferred with friends
belonging thereto, and find them united in believing
that such a meeting would be useful, and we uniting
with them, in prospect, with submission propose to the
monthly meeting the establishment thereof, said meet-
ing to be held the day preceding the monthly meeting.
