

14th of the 8th Month 1806

Communication was received from the Quarterly meeting as follows, John McElin, William Haywards, George Elliott, and William Brown, were appointed to attend the opening of the meeting, at the west end of the City - and produce to that preparative a list of the members composing it, and the overseers residing within the verge thereof were directed in future to report thereto. -

11th of 9th Month 1806

The Committee to attend the opening of Lombard street preparative meeting, reported that they attended, they further informed that they have not fully completed the list of the members composing that meeting they were continued.

23rd of the 10th Month 1806

At an adjourned meeting.

The Friends to collect the names of the members composing Lombard street meeting were continued & directed to make out a list of the members belonging to our three preparative meetings, a separate one to be delivered to each of them, also to collect and return to the recorder and account of the births and burials that have not been recorded. The following Friends were added to the Committee, James Brown, Hugh Balderson, William Tipton and Joshua Mott.

12th of the 5th Month 1807

Lombard street preparative meeting requested the privilege of holding a monthly meeting in their meeting house on

the 1st day preceding the second fifth day in each month, and that their preparative meeting be held on the 1st day next preceding, which was referred to our next.

9th of the 11th Month 1807

The request brought up to our last from Lombard street preparative meeting being revived, was united with, it was also agreed that this meeting be in future called the Monthly meeting of Baltimore for the Eastern District, and that the meeting proposed to be established be distinguished by the name of the Monthly meeting of Baltimore for the Western District, and that each of our preparative meetings in this City be ^{in future} so distinguished, it was also our sense that the meeting for ministers and Elders continue to be held as heretofore. Friends of Elk Ridge ~~was~~ requested to be united with Lombard street preparative by becoming a branch of the Monthly meeting of Baltimore for the Western District, and proposed that their week day meeting for the future be discontinued in the week of the monthly meeting, their request was concurred with and the subject directed to be forwarded to the ^{Quarterly} meeting.

14th of the 5th Month 1807

The following minute from the Quarterly meeting was received.
