And also informs that Friends of Eldridge preparative meeting have requested to be united with the Friends of Lombard Street preparative by becoming a branch of the proposed monthly meeting, and more over that their week day meeting in future be discontinued in the week of the monthly meeting, and that after weighty deliberation they had concurred with this request, and directed the foregoing subjects to be forwarded ^{to the Quarterly meeting} for consideration, which after claiming the solid deliberation of this meeting was united with, and the monthly meeting for the Western District to be opened in the 1st month next and Thomas Moore, John Thomas, Joseph Thornburgh, Jacob Tyson, Joshua Husband, & Silas Warner, are appointed to attend the opening of the new monthly meeting, as also, that of the Eastern District.

11th of the 6th Month 1807.

John Wilson, John McElin, John Trimble & James Brown, were appointed to unite with a Committee of the monthly meeting for the Western District, in examining into the situation of such local concerns as may be found to interest both meetings & report thereon to our next.

7th 8th & 9th Month, 1807 continued.

8th of the 10th Month 1807.

The Committee on Local concerns brought in the following reports. We of the Committee appointed by the monthly meetings of the Eastern and Western Districts, of Baltimore agree to propose to our respective meetings that the monthly meeting for the Eastern District shall pay thirty eight cents and the monthly meeting for the Western District sixty two cents in the Dollar as their respective proportions of the Yearly meeting stock formerly paid by Baltimore monthly meeting, and that the Library remain for the use of both meetings untill otherwise disposed of.
