The following extract from a Minute of the Yearly
meeting, in relation to the case forwarded to
that, meeting for decision was produced & read
and the Clerk directed to forward a copy thereof
and of this minute to the two monthly meetings of
Baltimore, for the Eastern and Western Districts,
Signed on behalf of this meeting - V. J. -

"The committee appointed at a former sitting on the
case, brought up in the reports from Baltimore
Quarterly meeting produced the following written
Report, which was read and united with and the
Clerk directed to furnish that meeting with a
copy thereof, and also of this minute. -

"To the Yearly Meeting now sitting"

On the committee appointed to state the case -

Brought forward, in the report, from Baltimore
Quarterly meeting, and also to report our judgement
thereon, having twice met, reviewed and examined
all the Papers, and documents relative thereto which
was produced, to us - It appears that a difficulty
had arisen between the two monthly meetings held in
the City of Baltimore, concerning the right of the Pro-
perty belonging to friends, and situated in the eastern
end of this City - and notwithstanding we found the
undertaking an arduous one, yet we were favoured
to unite in judgement, that as the title of the lots
secured to friends in this City and vicinity the right of
a Burying Grounds thereon, that the monthly meeting
for the western district shall be at liberty to enter
their deceased, in the Grounds now laid off, for that
purpose, or in any addition thereto, which may be found
necessary, they paying their proportional part of the
expenses, that may be hereafter incurred in keeping
the same inclosed, and any other needful repairs -
so long as they continue to occupy the same, - and
that all the other part of the lots, & the buildings there-
on be considered as property belonging to the monthly
meeting for the Eastern District. - And that any
lots heretofore held by the monthly meeting of Baltimore
before the Division took place be kept in common for the
