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Regulations of the Committee appointed to the care of the Burying Ground.

14th of the 11th Month 1800.

The following regulations of the Committee appointed to the care of the Burying Grounds were produced in which was considered, approved, and the Committee directed to proceed accordingly viz —

Copy of the regulations agreed to by the Committee appointed to the care of the Burying Grounds and oversight of Interments. — Extracted from their proceedings 11th Month 30th 1800. —

1. That on the decease of a member, the Grave Digger is directed to attend to any order given by the Committee, either written, or verbal, or of any Individual member of Society in case of their absence. —

2. Those that are not members, are not to be admitted without a written order, signed at least by two of the Committee, to be mentioned therein accordingly — and as this description are numerous, and the Ground heretofore, considerably taken up by them — It is the sense of the Committee, that in future, they be not admitted, in the City Burying ground, except in such instances where some of their near connections

are interred therein.

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3^d That the Grave digger charge for the grave of every grown person, the sum of Two Dollars and for every child one Dollar and Seventy five cents with the additional sum of Seventy five cents for the former, and fifty cents for the latter for the purpose of sodding and keeping them in repair.

4th The Preparative meeting in the 4th month last having reserved out of the Pasture lot, the distance of thirty feet, along the North side of the Burying Ground first laid off, as an addition thereto, It is directed that no Grave be opened North of the line of the said thirty feet, running parallel with the upper part of the Burying Ground aforesaid. —

5th It is considered to be the duty of the Committee that one or more of them attend all Funerals — admitted into the Burying Grounds, & endeavour that good order be preserved, — Particularly when Interments are to take place before the sitting of a Public Meeting to be careful that the hour of Meeting be not infringed upon thereby. —
