This Indenture made the sixteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven Hundred and sixty five. Between Thomas Sligh of Baltimore County in the Province of Maryland, of the one part, and John Deavor of Baltimore Town in the same County and Province, Brickmaker of the other part Witnesseth, that the said Thomas Sligh for and in consideration of the sum of Ten pounds current Money to him in hand by the said John Deavor paid, the receipt whereof the said Thomas Sligh doth hereby acknowledge and himself to be therewith fully satisfied contented

and paid. He hath granted, Bargained, sold, aliened, infeoffed, and confirmed; and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, infeoffe, and confirm unto the said John Deavor his Heirs and assigns forever all the part of a Tract of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid, near to Baltimore Town called Mountains neck, which is contained within the following metes and bounds viz. Beginning at the end of the South seventeen degrees East twenty six perches line of a parcel of Land heretofore conveyed by the said Thomas Sligh unto a certain Fielder Hunt, and running thence bounding on the said parcel of Land North seventeen degrees West Ten perches and twelve feet, then North Seventy three degrees East ten perches, South Seventeen degrees East twenty two perches, untill it intersects @
