read, and is as follows.

Session 1793 Chap. 20th
An Act, To confirm the Title of certain
of Ground to the Society of People called Quakers

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in Baltimore Town, wherein is their Meeting
house and Burying Ground.

Whereas, it is represented to this Legislature
by the Monthly Meeting of the people called Quakers,
in Baltimore Town, that they are seized, and
possessed of a Lot of Ground on the East side of Jones
Hills included within Mark, Haverford and Pitt streets
and Smoke Alley, containing by computation
