

Society, shall hold more than two Acres of Ground without the leave of the Legislature, and the said Monthly Meeting hath prayed a law might pass to vest the Legal Estate in the Trustees of said Meeting and their heirs and Assigns, for the purposes aforesaid, and the prayer of said petition being reasonable, therefore —

2^d Be it Enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland that it shall and may be lawful for the Trustees of said Society to have and to hold the property and Lots above described to them their Heirs and Assigns forever, saving to all and every person their several and respective rights. —

3^d Provided always and be it Enacted that the said property and Lots shall be held and enjoyed for a meeting house, yard, —

stabling, burying ground, School house, and Dwelling house, and small garden, to accommodate said School master, or person taking care of said property, and for no other use or purpose whatever. —
