This Indenture of Five parts, made this fourth day of April, in the year Eighteen hundred. Between, Bernard Hopkins of the city of Baltimore of the first part. Robert Cornthwaite, George Matthews and David Brown all of the city aforesaid of the second part. John Deaver of the city aforesaid of the third part, John McLean and Joseph Townsend of the city aforesaid of the fourth part, and Bernard Hopkins, Isaac Tyson, John Dutchart, and John Trumble (of Isaac) all of the city aforesaid of the fifth part. Whereas

a certain Andrew Stigar late of the city of Baltimore aforesaid deceased, by his certain Deed of Indenture bearing date the nineteenth day of June in the year Sixteen hundred and seventy three for the considerations therein mentioned did grant bargain sell and convey unto John Cornthwaite late of the city of Baltimore deceased and the said Bernard Hopkins their heirs Executors and administrators, a certain piece or part of a Tract of Land lying and being in Baltimore County and on the North side of the north west Branch of Patapsco River being part of a Tract of Land called Mountmays Neck formerly taken up by Alexander Mountmays. Beginning at the end of John Deavers north Seventy three Degrees, East ten perches line of one Acre of Ground which John Deaver formerly
