This Indenture made this sixteenth day of March in the year eighteen hundred and one Between Mary Bunker of the city of Baltimore of the one part, and Gerrard Hopkins, Isaac Tyson, John Dutchart and John Trimble (of Isaac) Trustees for the congregation of people called Quakers in the City of Baltimore of the other part: Whereas by Indenture bearing date on or about the Thirtieth day of June seventeen hundred and ninety four, and

made between John Spear, Samuel Smith and Margaret his wife, William Patterson and Dorcas his wife, William Lee Foreman and Jane his wife, and Barbara Spear, heirs of William Spear formerly of Baltimore Town deceased, of the one part, and the above named Mary Bunker, then Mary Anderson of the other part, they the said John Spear, Samuel Smith, and Margaret his wife William Patterson and Dorcas his wife William Lee Foreman and Jane his wife and Barbara Spear for the consideration therein mentioned did give grant, bargain, sell and confirm unto the said Mary Bunker her heirs and assigns forever all that part of these lots or parcels of ground situate and lying in a South East addition to Baltimore Town and distinguished on a
