

Tyson, John Dutcher, and John Trimble of Isaac
or any person or persons succeeding them in this Trust
who shall hereafter fall from or change his or their
religious principles aforesaid or depart from the said
congregation, or who shall cease to be a member or
members thereof shall be capable to execute this
Trust or stand seized to the use aforesaid nor
have any right or interest in the said premises.

And Upon this further Trust that when
and as often as the said Trustees by their Mortality,
shall be reduced to the number one, that then and
in such case it is hereby declared to be the true
intent and meaning of these presents, and the said
parties that the surviving Trustee shall by good
assurances in the Law, convey the said premises—
above mentioned with the appurtenances unto

Four more of the most sufficient and substantial
persons of the said congregation and their heirs
who shall be chosen by a Baltimore monthly
meeting of the said congregation when convened—
agreeably to the rules and regulations of the said
society. Upon the same Trusts and for the like
uses intents and purposes as are herein before
mentioned and declared, and so from time
to time forever hereafter, and as often
hereafter as the said Trustees shall be
reduced to the number one, whereby the
said Trusts thereof may have a perpetual
duration, and may not come to and be
vested in the heirs of any surviving Trustee,
any thing herein contained to the contrary
