This Indenture made the second day of December, in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred and six, Between Gerrard, T. Hopkins, Isaac Tyson, John Duke, John and John Trimble, Son of Isaac, all of the City of Baltimore in Baltimore County and State of Maryland: The Trustees of the Society of Quakers in the said City of Baltimore, of the one part; and James Stirling of the

same City, County and State, Merchant, of the one part; Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Six Hundred and Eighty Dollars, of good and Lawfull Money of the United States of America, to the said parties hereto of the first part in hand paid by the said James Stirling, at or before the Sealing and Delivery of these Presents, the Receipt whereof they the said Parties hereto of the first part, as Trustees as aforesaid, do hereby acknowledge, and confess. themselves to be therewith fully satisfied contented and paid, and of and from the same and every part and parcel thereof do acquit release and forever discharge the said James Stirling his Heirs
