Deed to be her act and Deed and the Lot of Ground and premises therein mentioned to be the right and Estate of James Ellicott, Philip C. Thomas, William Tyson, John Ellicott Junior, James Gillingham and John Marsh their heirs and assigns forever, for the uses and trusts therein mentioned. and declared that she made and executed the said Deed and this her acknowledgement thereof willingly and freely without being induced thereto by fear or threats of, or ill usage by her husband, or fear of his displeasure.
