third day of November in the year of our Lord
One Thousand eight hundred and three, Between
George Everhart of Baltimore county of the one
part, and James Ellicott, Philip & Thomas, William

and John Marsh Trustees for the Purposes herein
after mentioned of the other part. Witnesseth
that the said George Everhart for and in con-
sideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred
and twenty five Dollars, to him paid by the

said James Ellicott, Philip & Thomas, William
Tyson, John Ellicott, James Gillingham and John
Marsh at or before the sealing and delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
hath granted bargained sold assigned transferred
and set over, and by these presents Doth grant
bargain sell assign transfer and set over unto the
said James Ellicott, Philip & Thomas, William
Tyson, John Ellicott Junior James Gillingham and
John Marsh their executors administrators and
assigns all that part of a Lot of Ground situate
in Howards late addition to Baltimore Town
distinguished on the plat of said Town by the num-
ber Seven hundred and Twelve and Beginning
for the same at the end of six perches East from the
Intersection of Ectaw and Lombard Streets and run-
ning East binding on Lombard Street two Perches
