Nevertheless and for the several uses intents and purposes herein after mentioned and expressed, of and concerning the same and to and for none other uses intent or purpose whatsoever that is to say in the first place that the said piece or parcel of ground together with any improvements that are or may be erected thereon shall be and continue to be for the use and accommodation of the Yearly Meeting of the Society of the people called Quakers, held in the city of Baltimore and also for the accommodation of the said Society or congregation of People residing in the said city, and upon this further Trust that the said trustees when thereto required shall by a good and sufficient Deed convey and transfer the said piece or parcel of ground and premises to such person or persons, and to and for such uses and purposes, as may and shall be appointed, limited and agreed upon by the Monthly Meeting of

Baltimore for the Western District, with the approbation of the Yearly Meeting, or its representatives duly appointed, Provided Always that neither of the said Samuel G. Jones, Isaac Tyson, Izak Proctor, John Gillingham, Hugh Balderson and Andrew Ellicott, or any person or persons succeeding them in this Trust, who shall hereafter fall from or change his or their religious principles aforesaid, or depart from the said congregation, or who shall cease to be a member or members thereof shall be capable to execute this trust, or stand seized to the uses aforesaid, or have any right or interest in the said premises anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding.
