

Transfer of Trust

Whereas by Indenture bearing date on or about the twentieth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve, and made between John Eager Howard of Baltimore County, in the State of Maryland, Gentleman, of the one part, and Samuel G. Jones, Isaac Tyson, Isaac Procter, John Spillingham, Hugh Balderston and Andrew Ellicott, all of the City of Baltimore, in the County and State aforesaid of the other part, it is Witnessed that for the considerations therein expressed, the said John Eager Howard, did give grant, bargain and sell, alien, enfeoff, convey, release and confirm unto the said Samuel G. Jones, Isaac Tyson, Isaac Procter, John Spillingham, Hugh Balderston and Andrew Ellicott, their heirs and assigns, all that piece or parcel of Ground situate and lying in the City of Baltimore aforesaid, which is contained

within the metes and bounds, courses and distances following that is to say, Beginning for the same on the south side of Lombard street, at the distance of one hundred and ninety nine feet and seven inches, Easterly from the corner formed by the intersection of the South side of Lombard street, and the East side of Cutler street, the said beginning being at the North east corner of a brick wall inclosing a meeting house and the ground attached thereto, of the Society of People called Quakers, and the North west corner of a piece or parcel of Ground described in a deed, (bearing equal date with the aforesaid Indenture,) made between the said John Eager Howard, of the one part, and certain Rositer Scott, of the other part; and running thence Westerly bounding on Lombard street, one foot and seven inches to Lot number six hundred and ninety one, heretofore by Indenture bearing date on or about the ninth day of November, one thousand eight hundred and three, and recorded among the Land records of Baltimore County aforesaid, in Liber W.G.
