 pressed in the said deed, thence Southerly bounding on the
 said Lot number six hundred and ninety one, and parallel
 with Howard Street, to Whisking Alley, thence Easterly bound-
 ing on said Alley, one foot and seven inches, and thence Northward
 by a straight line to the place of beginning: Together with the
 appurtenances, To Hold, the same unto the said
 Samuel G. Jones, Isaac Tyson, Izak Proctor, John Gillingham
 Hugh Balderson and Andrew Ellicott, their heirs and
 assigns forever. In Trust, and for the several uses
 intents and purposes therein and herein after mentioned and
 expressed, of and concerning the same, and to and for none
 other use intent or purpose whatsoever: that is to say, in the
 first place that the said Piece or Parcel of Ground, together
 with any improvements that were or might be erected thereon,
 should be and continue to be for the use and accomodation of the

Yearly Meeting of the Society of People called Quakers,
 held in the City of Baltimore, and also for the accommo-
 dation of the said Society or Congregation of People residing in
 the said city; And upon this further Trust that the said
 Trustees when thereto required should by a good and suffici-
 ent deed convey and transfer the said piece or parcel of ground
 and premises to such person or persons, and to and for such
 uses and purposes, as might and should be appointed by the
 Monthly Meeting of Baltimore for the Western District,
 with the approbation of the Yearly Meeting or its represen-
 tatives duly appointed: which said Indenture contains a provi-
 so that neither the said Samuel G. Jones, Isaac Tyson, Izak
 Proctor, John Gillingham, Hugh Balderson, and Andrew
 Ellicott, or any person or persons succeeding them in that
 Trust, who should thereafter fall from or change his or their
 Religious principles aforesaid or depart from the said
 Congregation, or who shall cease to be a member or members
 thereof.
