 of the Opinion, that from the reduced number of the

Legal Trustees that an early application be made to  
 the Legislature now in Session for an Act to continue the  
 said Trust, and have accordingly prepared the follow-  
 ing memorial— were also free to propose that John  
 Trimble, John Dukehart, William Husband, Chas.  
 Balderston, Thomas Matthews, David Brown, and  
 William Procter receive the same on behalf of this  
 Meeting, all which is submitted.
