To Have and To Hold the said hereby bargained and sold pieces or parcels of land and premises with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Joseph Townsend, Thomas Poulney, William Ballinger, Eli Kirk, Isaac Ganney and Joseph Steer and their successors upon such trusts nevertheless that is to say upon this special trust that they the said Trustees Joseph Townsend, Thomas Poulney, Eli Kirk, William Ballinger, Isaac Ganney and Joseph Steer and their successors of them and such other person or persons who shall succeed in the Trust from time to time, shall and will permit and suffer all that the above described pieces or parcels of land and premises to be and continue to be a pasture for the use of the said religious Society of people called Quakers, and to and for no other use or
