Maria Kerly's acknowledgment
was again read, and after nightly
deliberation thereon, Elizabeth Gillingham
Rachel Hough and Martha ^{Carey} were
appointed to pay her another visit
and report.

The friends appointed to
prepare a Certificate for Ann Weston
joined with her Husband, and Children
produced one, which was read and
approved. & The Clerk was directed
to sign it on the meetings behalf.

Men friends produced ^{the} following
Testimony of disavowment against
Sophia Sweatman, which was

read, approved, ³⁷ and signed, and the
same friends continued to show her
a copy thereof and inform her of her
privilege of appeal. and report—

Sophia Sweatman, a member of
our Society, has through inattention to
the dictates of truth in her own breast,
been guilty of unchastity and become the
mother of an illegitimate child— and
friends having treated with her in order
to bring her to a sense of her transgression
without the desired effect— we therefore
disown her from being a member of our
