The committee in the case of Ellen Spedall reported that they had again visited ^{her} in company with men friends, and that she still appeared in the same disposition of mind. They were ^{therefore} directed to prepare a testimony against her.

Catharine Leek, Mary Robertson, Hannah Hapler, and Ann Pope were named to attend at the doors during the time of our yearly meeting to prevent persons not in membership from sitting our meetings for discipline.
