7th Answer: friends are generally careful to live within the bounds of their circumstances and to avoid involving themselves in business beyond

their ability to manage and mostly exact in their dealings and punctual in complying with their engagements.

8th Answer: Most friends are careful to bear a testimony against slavery, and to provide for those under their direction who have had their freedom secured and many friends are careful to instruct them in useful learning.

9th Answer: Questions are dealt with nearly as desired.
