

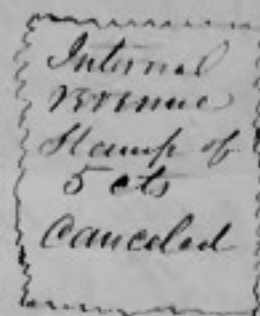

And moreover they the said Bartholomew Wistar Beesley and Margaret Cheston Coale (she according to the custom of Marriage, assuming the name of her Husband) did, as a further confirmation thereof then and there to these presents set their hands.
